Porter is a nationally renowned consumer advocate who has spent nearly two decades fighting Wall Street banks and powerful financial institutions who cheat families. She was <u>one of the first</u> people to sound the alarm about Wall Street's abuses against homeowners during the mortgage crisis. And she fought tirelessly for Californians against the banks to help secure more than <u>\$18 billion in relief</u> for homeowners harmed during the crisis.

Porter's been endorsed in the CA-45 race by Kamala Harris and Elizabeth Warren, who both cited her national leadership fighting for families.
