Broad Coalition of Diverse Groups Continue to Rally in
Support of Eng with Backing of Nation's Largest Statewide
LGBTQ Civil Rights Organization.

EL MONTE, CA — Former Assemblymember and Educator Mike Eng today won an additional major endorsement in his race for the 22nd State Senate District, this time that of Equality California.

“Mike Eng’s record in the fight for LGBTQ rights speaks for itself,” stated Rick Zbur, Executive Director of Equality California. “In the California Assembly, Eng had a 100% pro-equality voting record and clearly established himself as a strong ally to the LGBTQ community with his work to prevent bullying in our schools and to improve the safety of LGBTQ students. In 2008, as a member of the Assembly, Eng came out strongly against Proposition 8 and partnered with API Equality Los Angeles to mobilize the Asian Pacific Islander communities and others to support marriage equality. We are proud to endorse Mike Eng for State Senate and have no doubt that if elected, he will continue to champion the civil rights of LGBTQ people.”

DISCLAIMER INFOFORMATION

Contributions to Mike Eng for Senate 2018 (ID# 1344121) are not tax deductible as charitable contributions for federal income tax purposes. The California Political Reform Act places limits on contributions to candidates for state office. Individuals, corporations, unions, PACs, and other entities may contribute a maximum of \$4,400. to the committee per election, primary and general, for a total of \$8,500. A registered small contributor committee may contribute a maximum of \$8,800. per election. Spouses and domestic partners may each contribute from a joint account but both must sign the check or credit card authorization form. Contributions must be made voluntarily from the donor's own funds and may not be reimbursed by any other person or business. Contributions from foreign nationals or persons under the age of eighteen are not permitted.

Contributions of \$100 or more will be sent back to the contributor if address, occupation and employer information is NOT provided
