CALIFORNIA CONFERENCE OF MACHINISTS JOINS LODGES 725 AND 947, BACKS THORBURN

Trio of Machinist organizations join flood of labor organizations backing Thorburn's bid for Congress **ORANGE COUNTY, CA** -- Continuing a torrent of labor organizations backing former AFT Leader Andy Thorburn in his campaign for Congress, today, Thorburn announced he has earned endorsements from the California Conference of Machinists, as well as Machinists District Lodges 725 and 947, in his campaign for Congressional District 39.


"The California Conference of Machinists, as well as the Southern California Machinists District Lodge 725 and District Lodge 947 are proud to endorse former classroom teacher Andy Thorburn for Congress," said Larry Olinger, President of Machinists District Lodge 725 and Sal Vasquez, President of Machinists District Lodge 947, in a joint statement. "Andy has proven through action that he will stand for working families. The machinists believe in his values and commitment to betterment through collective bargaining and organizing the unorganized. Andy doesn't just talk about fighting for working families, he's got a proven record. He was jailed for nearly a month for helping to lead a strike for classroom teachers to raise wages and improve working conditions. In the end, he and working families won, earning a collective bargaining agreement that raised wages and ensured better working conditions. We need this kind of bold leadership fighting on behalf of working families every day in Washington, and that's why we are pleased to support Andy's campaign. Andy is the choice of the Machinists for Congress."

The three Machinists organizations join the California Nurses Association, the United Steelworkers, the Communications Workers of America Local 9510, and International Union of Painters and Allied Trades, who have all previously backed Thorburn.
