

CALIFORNIA DEMOCRATS OVERWHELMINGLY REJECT 25-YEAR U.S. SENATE INCUMBENT

SAN DIEGO, CA – Tonight 63% of California Democratic Party delegates rejected Senator Feinstein, and voted for change. More than 54% of those delegates supported Kevin de León, while only 37% voted for Senator Dianne Feinstein. State Senator Kevin de León released the following statement:

"The outcome of today's endorsement vote is an astounding rejection of politics as usual, and it boosts our campaign's momentum as we all stand shoulder-to-shoulder against a complacent status quo.
