Frank Scotto Endorsed by Former Manhattan Beach Mayor Bob Holmes

TORRANCE - Bob Holmes, retired Mayor of Manhattan Beach, has endorsed small business owner and former Torrance Mayor Frank Scotto in his bid for the California State Assembly.

Currently, Scotto and his wife, Cindy, live in Torrance. Scotto is still active in the community, volunteering with numerous local organizations, including the Arts Council of Torrance; Torrance

Sister City Association; the Torrance Rose Float Association; and the Chambers of Commerce of Torrance, Redondo Beach, and Lomita.

Frank Scotto is the former Mayor of Torrance. He is running for State Assembly in the 66th Assembly District, which encompasses much of the South Bay of Los Angeles.
