## JOHN CHIANG ENDORSED BY SAN FERNANDO VALLEY YOUNG DEMOCRATS

Chiang got his first experience in California politics as a volunteer with the Democratic Party, where he registered voters in the San Fernando Valley.

The San Fernando Valley Young Dems is the latest major endorsement for Chiang's campaign, joining California NOW (National Organization for Women), the West Los Angeles Democratic Club, the Fontana Democratic Club, the Culver City Democratic Club, IBEW Local 47, UNAC/UHCP, AFSCME District Council 36, the Silicon Valley Asian Pacific American Democratic Club, NPE Action, Congresswoman Linda Sanchez (CA-38), Los Angeles City Controller Ron Galperin, the Black Young Democrats of Sacramento, the AAPI Democratic Club of San Diego, and so many others that have all endorsed in recent weeks.

As a member of the state Board of Equalization, as state controller, and as state treasurer, Chiang has consistently fought for the future of California's young people:

- Chiang has put forward a <u>higher education plan</u> that will ensure
   Californians have first priority when it comes to enrollment at public
   universities and colleges, rolls back tuition and fees for the University of
   California and California State University systems, and makes it easier
   for students to refinance their loans.
- Chiang has also released an <u>education plan</u> that would invest more in K-12 education, obtain and train new teachers, and invest more in public education.
- Chiang convened California's first Green Bond Symposium to come up with ways to turbocharge the innovative, new green bond market, with an eye toward unlocking its potential to pay for billions of dollars in investments in our green infrastructure.

   <u>prevent sexual harassment and abuse in Sacramento</u> and throughout
   state government.
- As state treasurer, Chiang has been the state's leader in working to fund affordable housing and revamped his office's affordable housing programs — increasing development by 80% since 2014. He's now working to <u>place a roof over the heads of an additional four million low</u> and moderate-income Californians in the next decade.
- By restructuring California's state debt to generate more than \$7 billion for schools, infrastructure, and public safety, Chiang brought back our failing state economy.
