In a statement released following the announced endorsement, Lt. Governor Gavin Newsom declared:

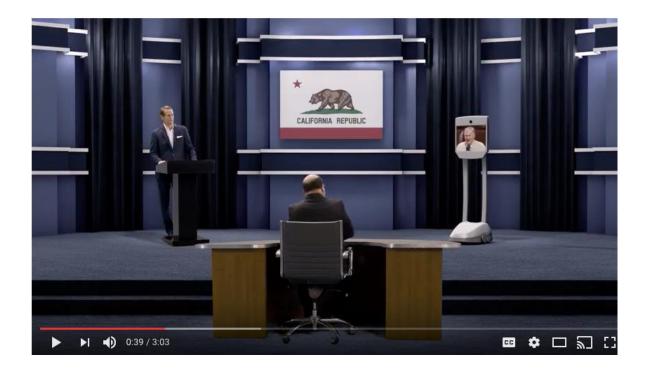
"I am proud to endorse Harley Rouda for Congress. I know he will be an effective and fearless fighter for the people of Orange County, and will work to move all of America forward."
