## President Barack Obama Endorses Buffy Wicks for California State Assembly, District 15

**Berkeley, CA.--** Today former United States President Barack Obama endorsed Buffy Wicks to serve as the next Assemblymember for District 15. Buffy Wicks worked for President Obama for 6 years both in the White House as Deputy Director of Public Engagement and served as a top litueient in both of Obama's presidential campaigns, including as California Field Director. Wicks is credited as one of the primary architects of Obama's grassroots organizing model.
