Motor Voter Law Reregisters 23,000 People Incorrectly

California. -- California Secretary of State candidate Mark Meuser issued the following statement on the revelation by the Department of Motor Vehicle's incorrect registration of 23,000 people, including changing some party registration.

"Between the [Los Angeles County voting roll](#) incident in the primary election, the [MIT election lab rating](#) in August, and now the DMV's failure today, the incompetence of the Secretary of State office is blatantly apparent," said Meuser. "This is further eradicating people's trust in our voting system. It should be the Secretary of State's mission to ensure that we have integrity in our elections and people can trust their outcomes, but it is obviously not."

Mark Meuser is an election law attorney in the San Francisco area. He has recently completed a 5,000-mile, 58 county bicycle tour to highlight the issues with our current election system and discuss his vision to restore it.
