NPR Debate Reaction: Leaders Don't Lie, They Take a Stand

Leaders know the issues, take a stance, and make tough decision. It was clear, after <u>listening to</u> the KQED/NPR District 4 candidate forum that **Rep. Tom McClintock is that leader.**

McClintock: "I actively support Prop 6 to repeal that tax. Where do you stand?" Morse: "I think I just answered that..." [SPOILER: She didn't] McClintock: "Yes or no?" Morse: "I support federal infrastructure funding and the California voters will make a decision on Prop 6..." McClintock: "So you're not taking a position on that or other key issues."

2. Justice Kavanaugh

McClintock outlined a clear argument for why the Kavanaugh confirmation hearings were a partisan show, ruining the reputation of an upstanding judge—all for Sen. Feinstein and the Left to put points on the board. And Americans saw right through their charade.

Disregarding our Constitution's principles of law and order, Jessica Morse outlined what she saw as "justice": Accusation = Conviction. That's not what those in #CA04 would deem a fair and just society.

3. #VagabondLyfe

Another candidate forum, another misrepresentation. When asked again by NPR to explain her dishonesty about her record and resume, Morse doubled down.
