Eggman was first elected to the State Assembly in 2012 after serving on the Stockton City Council.

Eggman is the Chair of the Assembly Agriculture Committee and is the former Chair of the Legislative Women’s Caucus.

SD 5 Notes:

Eggman currently represents almost half of SD 5. In her latest Assembly campaign – Eggman won with over 65% of the vote (almost 75,000 total votes). SD 5 consists of portions of Sacramento, Stanislaus and San Joaquin Counties – with San Joaquin making up over 72%. Current registration shows an almost 10% Democratic registration advantage. Hillary Clinton won this seat in 2016 by almost 35,000 votes.
