Dave Cortese Raises Over \$650,000 For State Senate Run

*Campaign Continues to See Significant Fundraising
Momentum Post-Deadline*

SAN JOSE, CA – Santa Clara County Supervisor Dave Cortese is excited to report a fundraising total exceeding \$650,000 through the June 30th reporting deadline in his run for State Senate District 15. Significant contributions have continued to flow in following the June 30th deadline, bringing the cash-on-hand total to more than \$600,000.

More than 600 community leaders representing a broad coalition attended the June 29th campaign kickoff event.



"Our campaign has undeniable momentum," Cortese said. "Our message and my track record resonate. Homelessness, affordable housing, economic inequality, public safety and education: these are issues I've been committed to tackling as a public servant. I look forward to continuing that work in the Senate."

Cortese co-chaired the 2016 Measure A campaign, a \$950 million affordable housing bond. He also initiated the creation of a housing task force with representatives from business, labor, and city and county offices, as well as the homeless community, which led to Measure A being placed on the ballot. Along with the American Leadership Forum, Cortese will host a community summit on homelessness on September 21st at the Santa Clara Fairgrounds, continuing his commitment toward combating California's homelessness crisis.
